

**Request for Proposals
Resilience and Climatological Data
Questions and Answers**

Q. Will a non-US registered company who does not have any employees in the US be excluded from the tender process if it does not participate in a Federal Work Authorization Program in accordance with the applicability provisions and deadlines established in O.C.G.A 13 -10 91 and so is unable to sign the Georgia Security And Immigration Compliance Act Contractor Affidavit?

A. A non-US based business may submit a proposal even if they do not participate in a Federal Work Authorization Program.

However, if a business physically hires employees in the United States, have a designated US location, or fall under specific federal contractor regulations, a Georgia Security And Immigration Compliance Act Contractor Affidavit is required.

Q. Will a non-US registered company who does not have any employees in the US be excluded from the tender process if it does not possess a Federal Employee Identification Number (FEIN) or a Social Security Number?

A. A non-US based business may submit a proposal if they are able to provide valid government documentation (i.e. W-8BEN-E, W-8EXP, etc.) for tax purposes.

Q. Does the 10-page limit for proposals exclude a copy of the company's data license agreement for the use of the Flood Hazard Maps by ARC?

A. The data license agreement can be attached as an appendix, which will not count towards the 10-page limit.
